Study visit I

Cash Converters is a private company that believes in second chances. In fact, they have been proving it for more than 25 years by extending the life of millions of second-hand items. In other words, they are backed by more than two decades in which their work has focused on getting the circular economy rolling, thus promoting more sustainable consumption that is respectful of our Planet.

Study visit II

Geltoki is a participatory, open and non-profit project promoted by fifty social organizations and managed by a social initiative cooperative.

After the closure in 2007 of the emblematic Pamplona bus station, it fell into disuse and REAS Navarra proposes the use of the space as a reference centre for the social and solidarity economy. For several years, this initiative added the support and commitment of other entities, associations and social groups that work in the field of solidarity economy and food sovereignty, until it is finally formed by five partner entities and many other collaborators, the Geltoki Iruñea Association, which is awarded the use of the municipal space that the project currently occupies.

Geltoki kooperatiba is the current manager of the [Geltoki](#) space. Promoted by the Geltoki Iruñea association, the cooperative was formed in June 2018 and currently has a total of 10 cooperative members, being, like the association and the project, a non-

profit initiative. Its mission is to develop the project activity in all its areas, adopting and guaranteeing the implementation of the values and philosophy of the Geltoki Iruñea Association.

The Geltoki project aims to become a benchmark in the promotion of the social and solidarity economy, food sovereignty and alternative culture in Iruñerria. A service for Navarrese citizens and a speaker for this broad network of alternative and transformative initiatives; an open and plural proposal that promotes the social fabric.

Its philosophy: The project integrates the framework of the Charter of Principles of the Solidarity Economy, whose adaptation involves applying equity, the creation of decent working conditions combining spaces for social participation, environmental sustainability, cooperation, non-profit nature or commitment to the around.

The visit will focus in two main initiatives in Geltoki:

- [Repair café](#): An open space for the repair of objects and the exchange of knowledge.
- [Trastoteka](#) / Junk place: It works similar to a library but you borrow things instead of books. Those things that you use very sporadically, that may not be necessary to buy, and it is enough for you to use them when you need them.

Study visit III

Study visit IV

Traperos de Emaús is a group of more than 300 people that prioritizes welcoming people with difficulties and fighting for a more just and supportive world. Their legal form is a non-profit Foundation that includes a Ltd. as an Insertion Company.

[Traperos de Emaús](#) facilitates labour incorporation through the work of collecting, reusing and recycling objects that they put up for sale in their stores.

They collect furniture, WEEE, textiles and footwear, various objects and books. In 2023, they collected a total of 2,998,398 kg. of WEEE, of which 99.1% were recovered.

[What do they do?](#) They are "junkpeople/rag and bone people", an old trade from which they obtain their resources and which they update with Selective Collection, Preparation for Reuse and Recycling of objects and materials from waste in agreements with the 16 waste local entities of Navarra and different ERP Systems, and put it up for sale in their 8 stores in diverse locations of Navarra.

Traperos de Emaús visit: who are they?, some service from the MCP, EEE/WEEE management plant, Berriozar store:

- [Awareness activities](#): Traperos is always open to anyone who wants to meet them. They currently carry out visits for primary and secondary schools, vocational training (T&D) and the general public in agreement with the Commonwealth of Pamplona (MCP).
 - [Audiovisual Classroom and Workshops](#): Traperos de Emaús has provided these spaces for the Environmental Education program of the Commonwealth of the Pamplona (MCP). Free courses are held in the workshop classroom from October to June.
 - [Self-repair workshop](#): a place where tools and spaces are provided so that anyone can come and repair their objects. This workshop has been enabled in agreement with the Commonwealth of Pamplona (MCP). A free tool loan

service is also offered, that is, a Tool Bank that allows you to take tools home for a week to repair damaged objects there. Both the tools of the Workshop and those of the Tool Bank have been financed by the Waste Fund of the Government of Navarra.

- [Preparation centre for reuse and recycling](#) (we will focus on the EEE/WEEE space): A Centre of more than 20,000 m² in which they want to improve processes and promote the reuse of objects, citizen awareness and job creation. When an object arrives at the Berriozar Centre, they always try to prepare it for reuse and give it a second life. If this is not possible, they prepare the object for recycling.

The process of collected objects is:

- Manual classification.
 - Preparation for Reuse: check, clean and/or repair discarded objects so that they can be reused by other people.
 - Preparation for Recycling: separate and classify the parts and materials that make up the object to enable its reuse as spare parts or raw materials.
- [Berriozar store](#): opened since 2018. Sales allow them to make a living from their work and give things a second chance.
